What data do we collect?

Our Company collects the following data:

- Personal identification information: email address
- · Name and address of the organization you work for

How do we collect your data?

You directly provide Our Company with the data we collect. We collect data and process data when you:

- Register online or place an order for any of our products or services.
- Voluntarily complete a customer survey or provide feedback on any of our message boards or via email.

How will we use your data?

Our Company collects your data so that we can:

- Process your order, manage your account.
- Send you emails regarding the details of your order and next steps, as well as special offers on other products and services we think you might like.

How do we store your data?

Our Company securely stores your data using certified cloud / storage providers who follow the highest standards of data protection, e.g. Hetzner Online GmbH (Industriestr. 25; 91710 Gunzenhausen; Germany).

Switzerland has an adequate level of data protection according to the EU data protection legislation, so transfers can occur without additional safeguards under specific conditions.

Our Company will keep your email for 3 years. Once this time period has expired, we will delete your data by removing it from our system, unless you place new orders / continue cooperating with us in any other manner during this period - in such case, the data storage period will be extended taking into account the last date of any such interaction.

Marketing

If you have agreed to receive marketing materials, you may always opt out at a later date.

You have the right at any time to stop Our Company from contacting you for marketing purposes.

What are your data protection rights?

Our Company would like to make sure you are fully aware of all of your data protection rights. Every user is entitled to the following:

The right to access - You have the right to request Our Company for copies of your personal data. We may charge you a small fee for this service.

The right to rectification - You have the right to request that Our Company correct any information you believe is inaccurate. You also have the right to request Our Company to complete information you believe is incomplete.

The right to erasure - You have the right to request that Our Company erase your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to restrict processing - You have the right to request that Our Company restrict the processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to object to processing - You have the right to object to Our Company's processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to data portability - You have the right to request that Our Company transfer the data that we have collected to another organization, or directly to you, under certain conditions.
